Minutes: Reviewed and approved

Financials: Each team had their financials attached. Most of them have a positive balance. The second half of the club fees are due by 2/1/06.

High School Boys: Team registration next Tuesday. Pat Cell is the High School Boys coordinator.

Winder indoor: Clinics are underway. We have been getting some good feedback. Skills is included in the club fee. We also have FASTER and goalie training along with different indoor tournaments and leagues scheduled.

Winter Tournament: The indoor tournament for Thanksgiving didn't turn out. We need to do a better job of advertising. President's Day Tournament scheduled for January.

Outdoor Tournament dates: 4/29-30/06 for Spring tournament. The highschool boys have a mandatory weekend on 5/5-5/6/06. This could possibly be like a tournament weekend. We would need to get a ref assignor. Run 16 fields at 1 ½ hour increments with potential revenue from concessions.

Fall- 2 weeks before Labor Day to free up Collinsville or the weekend before. Jim is looking at the competing tournaments.

Xmas parade: Included 95 boys and 92 girls. This was successful and the kids had fun.

Cricket coming to SFC- River City United Cricket Club is interested in renting field area to play at our site. They use a 70 yd flat circle and they have to lay a concrete pitch. The season begins in May and runs through September, 14 games on weekends. They would practice here too. They have their own insurance. \$1000 is what the league pays for them to rent. We need to talk to Lou and Scott Huffman as being ground keepers. Laying of the concrete pitch wouldn't be till March.

Rough Riders: They were here last spring and we received a \$9000 advertising package and \$2000/100 hrs of field time on the large field. They are approaching us again for this spring. We would definitely need to up the rate. Their season starts in March. The feeling at the meeting was that it would be ok if the price is right.
